


DEAR PARENTS,




Take a rectangular sheet and fold it in half. Then unfold it.




Fold the sheet in half in the other direction.




Fold down both corners from the top to the centre, along the length of the fold.




At the bottom of the sheet, fold the two triangles upward, one on each side.




Grasp the centre of both triangles and pull them apart to obtain the shape in Figure 6.




Fold the lower triangle towards the top and do the same with the triangle on the other side.



Grasp the centre of the bottom of both triangles and pull them apart to obtain the shape in Figure 8.



Grasp the two top corners and separate them.


At the bottom of the sheet, fold the two triangles upward, one on each side.




Grasp the centre of both triangles and pull them apart to obtain the shape in Figure 6.




Fold the lower triangle towards the top and do the same with the triangle on the other side.
