# **2023-2024 Highlights**

### **JULY 2023 TO JUNE 2024**

Towards a concerted strategic planning 2024-2028

Throughout the year, R3USSIR stayed the course and implemented its approach for mobilization and concerted strategic planning. The organization met with over 322 people to work together to determine a series of priorities for action for 2024-2028.





#### **JULY AND AUGUST 2023**

## 13 summer initiatives across Estrie

R3USSIR supported 13 local projects as part of its summer strategy to encourage young people with their educational success in Estrie.

Conception of a project to promote in-demand professions in Estrie

A total of 32 partners from various sectors came together to co-construct an ambitious project aimed at valorizing and promoting prioritized professions across Estrie. This meeting gave rise to the *Carrefour des professions* project which is currently under development.

#### **OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER 2023**

Inspiring initiatives for the À GO, on lit! fall campaign

More than 200 partners from the 9 territories of Estrie were mobilized as part of AGOL's fall 2023 campaign. R3USSIR's attendance at the Salon du livre de l'Estrie provided an excellent opportunity to directly meet over 300 young readers! Two days of rich exchanges in the Haute-Yamaska and Brome-Missisquoi regions

To better understand the realities, issues, and needs of the redesigned Estrie region regarding educational perseverance, success, and training-employment matching, R3USSIR held two days of group discussions that united nearly 175 players from the Brome-Missisquoi and Haute-Yamaska MRCs.



#### **JANUARY 2024**

Academic and psychosocial catch-up plan: R3USSIR is part of the solution!

R3USSIR supports 30 local projects as part of the Quebec Ministry of Education's (MEQ) academic and psychosocial catchup plan, including 23 new initiatives.

#### **FEBRUARY 2024**

15<sup>th</sup> edition of Hooked on School Days (HSD)

From February 12 to 16, everyone around R3USSIR gathered to help encourage and motivate young people to stay in school, including organizing activities related to school perseverance. The 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary event, which brought together nearly 200 partners, was a huge success!

#### **MARCH 2024**

Touring the region as part of the *Thinking Big with Parents* 

R3USSIR joined forces with the *Collectif* estrien 0-5 ans to support positive parenting in Estrie. Throughout the spring of 2024, 12 workshops were held, and a survey was conducted that allowed us to better understand the needs of 230 parents of children ages 0-8.



#### **AVRIL 2024**

## Unveiling regional action priorities at the annual Partners' Meeting

More than 80 participants in R3USSIR's consultation forums gathered for the annual Partners' Meeting. Participants learned about the regional priorities for action that had been determined by R3USSIR's mobilization and concerted strategic planning process and reflected upon the positive changes and collective actions thereby set in motion.

#### 9 employers named "Best Boss"

R3USSIR has announced the nine winners of the *My Boss is the Best* and christened them "employers engaged to educational success in Estrie". These employers were recognized for their best practices in school-work balance.

#### **MAY 2024**

Estrie's "Thinking Big with Parents": nearly 150 people gather to support better practices in parenthood

Stakeholders and partners from all sectors came together alongside parents to learn about what parents really need, as determined during the Estrie consultation tour, and to discuss the best possible solutions for achieving better collective support for positive parenting in Estrie.

## Summer strategy: new and improved turnkey services

To equip partners, project developers, and day camp employees in rolling out their summer activities, R3USSIR developed a comprehensive service offering that included various tools and turnkey resources.

#### **JUNE 2024**

Virtual presentations and discussions about the JeConcilie tool

Nearly 50 stakeholders in the realm of school-work balance participated in at least one of four virtual meetings held between March and June. The purpose of these presentations was to raise awareness regarding the *JeConcilie* tool, as well as discussing its possible use in Estrie and strategies for making it known to young people, businesses, and parents.
